



Covid 19 Policies and Procedures at The Courts of NWI

-Updated 7.25.2020-

We are living in uncertain times, with every day holding new struggles and challenges for our world. At The Courts of NWI, Our mission has always been and will continue to be to provide athletes, coaches, and parents with an environment desirable to be apart of through competition, fellowship and opportunities to increase not only athletic abilities on the court, field, or in the gym, but also develop skills essential to perpetuating the growth of teamwork and life skills. We want nothing but to ensure that everyone is as safe as possible, while still allowing the opportunity to get back to the sports we love.

To continue to combat the current situation, we have instilled several different procedures and policies to maintain a safe space for activities. We are sanitizing high contact areas with frequency, our staff are required to wear masks when interacting with our guests, as well as sanitizing after the facility is closed to the public.

As of Monday July 27th at 9am we will begin requiring that everyone who enters the facility wears a mask. We reserve the right to and will deny entry to anyone who does not comply with this policy. We believe, alongside state orders, that at this time it is in the best interest of everyone to wear masks, and for all of us to do everything we can to stop the spread. Everyone must wear a mask at all times, with the only three exceptions being if there is at least 6 feet in between the next individual, and you are eating or drinking. If there is not at least 6 feet in between, at no time should masks be taken off.

When you are finished, the mask must be worn again. The second exception is if you are medically exempt with verification of that. In addition, if you fall into one of the exempt categories on the Indiana Executive order 20-37, the use of a face mask will not be required. We are requiring guests to not enter the facility if they have been in contact with someone who has tested positive for Covid19 or is showing symptoms conducive to Covid19 until the individual has either tested negative for Covid 19 or is cleared by a medical professional. While our staff will continue to do all we can in an effort to create a safe environment, we will not be walking around the facility policing the mandate. We trust that everyone will do their part in being responsible and doing the right thing. I hope this will add some comfort and clarity so that we can continue to start to get to the new normal that we all are experiencing together!

We are offering an array of sports that we wish to continue to be able to host through the coming weeks and months. We all must work together to ensure that sports and life continues to open back up. We enjoy the opportunity to be together and serve you all on a daily basis, and want to continue to be able to do that! If for some reason our county, state, or country decides that it is in the best interest to close businesses, limit interaction, and isolate our society again, the purchases and registrations that had previously been made, but not used in any way or if this falls in the middle of a session, the remaining balance will be applied to an account under the registrants name, and can be used to register for any event at The Courts in the future. This credit will be valid for an entire year from the date of operations resuming or the date the credit is applied, if that comes second. Every registration will be handled in a case by case manner in which the Director and or Owner of The Courts of NWI will make a decision based on many different facets of each situation. We reserve the right to deny or allow credits based on every individual situation.
